Design of the course

The whole chain of response to Major Incidents is trained simultaneously: Scene, transport, hospitals, coordination & command. Training in Triage and individual patient-management with participation of rescue service, police and protection agencies. The course is totally interactive, starting with one day of preparative training in groups, followed by two full days of simulation exercises with participants active in their normal positions and with careful evaluation and analysis of the result of the response.

The course is based on the advanced simulation system (www.macsim.se).

The course has special focus on physical trauma after terrorist attacks & military conflicts.

Accommodation

Accommodation is not included in the course fee.

Nurses, paramedics and ambulance staff: Basic course 3 full days including lunches, except 1st day lunch. 350 €

Officers in fire, rescue, police and civil protection services, doctors and administrative staff: Basic course 3 full days including lunches, except 1st day lunch 350 €
