Not all hospitals have commercial systems to fashion an open abdomen

The Evidence

- Negative pressure wound therapy is the preferred way to fashion an open abdomen
- NPWT for an open abdomen may be home-made according to Barker's technique

- Steri drape n°2
- Laparotomy swabs n°2-3
- Jackson-Pratt n°1
- Scalpel
- Wall suction at -100 mmHg
