




# ADVANCED SURGICAL SKILLS FOR EXPOSURES IN TRAUMA COURSE PLUS



*Developed by the American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma, in conjunction with The Uniformed Services University (The Military Medical School in the US) the Advanced Surgical Skills Exposures for Trauma Course-Plus (ASSET+) is an expanded version of the regular ASSET required of US Military Surgeons. This 2 day hands-on course using fresh cadavers, teaches over 35 life, limb, and eyesight saving skills required to care for victims of trauma in conflict zones, humanitarian missions and austere environments when specialty care is not immediately available. The student to faculty ratio is one to one and each student will do every skill and repeat most of them on the second day in a testing fashion as well as additional skills to include craniotomy, amputations, Lateral Canthotomy, and vascular shunt/repair.*
